



Executive Master in Energy Management (EMEM) Scholarship for NGO/Non-Profits

Who is eligible?

The scholarship is open to all self-funding applicants for the September 2018 intake of the Executive Master in Energy Management programme who are employed by an NGO or Non-profit organization and intend to remain in the sector. Candidates will only be considered for the award if they have successfully applied for and been admitted to the programme before the scholarship deadline.

Criteria for awarding the scholarship

The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of future professional and leadership potential, as demonstrated by the quality of the essay submitted in support of the scholarship application. We will also be looking for candidates that can demonstrate a proven track record of success (educational and professional) through their EMEM programme application and performance at interview. The Admissions Committee will review all elements of your application to assess your potential contribution to the ongoing success of the EMEM and commitment to ESCP Europe Business School through ambassadorial work.

Amount of the award

The scholarship amount is £3000. It may not replace the deposit required to secure a place in the programme. The scholarship award will be credited to the student's tuition fee account.

Judging panel

The judging panel is made up of members of the Admissions Committee and includes representatives from the ESCP Europe Faculty, the EMEM Programme Director, and EMEM alumni. Successful candidates will be notified individually.



How to apply

You must submit the following documents:

- Completed scholarship application form
- Documents relating to the legal incorporation of your organisation The moral and financial reports for the past two years
- The most recent external audit of your organisation
- A short essay in answer to the following question:

'As a member of an NGO or Non-profit organisation, please outline how you will personally support the ongoing development of the NGO/Non-profit sector.'

Incomplete forms will not be considered. Applications may not be modified once they have been submitted.

Deadline for submission

Please note, applications for scholarships must be submitted to the same deadline as the programme application but will not be considered until after you have completed the admission process.
