





# Structure of the **Global Executive Ph.D.**

The Global Executive Ph.D. programme is a part-time programme to be completed in three to four years. It is composed of 2 Stages.

STAGE 1

# Stage 1 Coursework and First Research Paper

**Duration: 18 months** 

**Objective:** equip participants with the tools to conduct research and to write a Ph.D. dissertation.

This stage is structured around three residential weeks, during which candidates will attend 10 modules (6 Research Methods modules and 4+ Advanced Specialisation modules). At the end of this stage, candidates will have completed their First Research Paper (RP1) and will be eligible to receive an Executive Masters in Management Research ESCP Business School degree.



# Stage 2 Ph.D. Dissertation

**Duration:** 18\* or 30 months

**Objective:** enable participants to further develop and successfully complete their Ph.D. dissertation.

Participants are required to write a Ph.D. dissertation, which takes the form of a monograph or three publishable papers.

The Ph.D. dissertation defence is oral and open to the public. Participants who complete this stage will be eligible to receive the Global Executive Ph.D. ESCP Business School degree.







# Ph.D. DISSERTATION

Participants are required to write a Ph.D. dissertation, which can take the form of three publishable papers or a monograph. The Ph.D. dissertation defence is oral and open to the public.

Students are expected to complete the Executive Ph.D. in 4 years in total. However, students taking the accelerated track can complete the programme in 3 years. The programme must be completed in no more than 7 years.

Participants will be guided by their thesis advisors throughout this intellectual journey, and supported through coaching and the "research bootcamps" which will help orient and adjust their work.

Following the successful defence of the dissertation, participants will receive the Global Executive Ph.D. ESCP Business School degree.

# **Admission Requirements**

- A previous university degree: Masters (MBA or equivalent Masters), non-management Masters holders are required to take additional management courses from the ESCP Executive MBA programme
