<b>Eligibility conditions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have a non-French Bachelor Degree issued by a non-French Institution after having completed at least three years of university studies</li> <li>• Have studied in France for a maximum of one year</li> </ul>
<b>Testing centre</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You will be assigned to a testing campus based on your <b>current</b> country of residence</li> </ul>
<b>Compulsory documents</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Scan of passport or identity card</li> <li>• Bachelor Degree Diploma or, if you have not obtained it yet, a certificate of enrolment</li> <li>• Transcript of records obtained during your Bachelor Degree</li> <li>• Curriculum Vitae (CV)</li> <li>• Cover letter outlining your motivation to join the programme</li> <li>• Standardised English Test (TOEIC/ IELTS/TOEFL/CAMBRIDGE)* [valid 2 years]</li> <li>• Standardised Management Test (TAGE MAGE/GMAT/GRE/CAT)** [valid 5 years]</li> </ul> <p>* To be exempt from the English language test requirement, you must be a <u>native speaker</u> as proven by a passport (mark =18/20) or have carried out at least 3 years of university studies <u>in English in an English-speaking country</u> (mark =15/20). However, if you also have a standardised English test we suggest you upload it to the on-line application, as we will take the higher of the two marks.</p> <p>** If you are not able to sit a standardised management test, you may request to sit a replacement test on campus. Please note that the replacement test is not available if your testing center is Paris.</p>
