



Scholarships for Master in Management Students

First section

Financial need-based scholarships

ESCP Business School **need-based scholarships** may be granted to **European** and **Non-European** students admitted through the following admissions pathways:

- Classe préparatoire française (**admitted students before September 2026**)
- Engineering Partner Schools: Centrale/Supélec, ENSAE, ESTP and MinesParisTech
- Double Diplôme Sorbonne (**European** students only).
- Sportif de haut niveau (top-level athlete in France), registered on the national list.
- Talent Spring.
- Students admitted through the PreMaster Admission Test (PMAT)
- Students admitted through RUPE (Politecnico de Turin)
- **European** students admitted by the ESCP Direct Admissions or by "Join a school in France" (SAI) are also eligible.

The following student categories are **not** eligible for financial need-based scholarships:

- Apprentices (Apprenticeship Track)
- Incoming Double Degree students
- Non-European students admitted by the ESCP Direct Admissions
- Non-European students admitted by "Join a school in France" (SAI).
- Visiting students

Students who are eligible for CROUS* scholarships may also be eligible for an ESCP need-based scholarship. The table below shows the percentages of exemption according to the CROUS scale:

Students who are eligible for CROUS scholarships, level 4 to 7, could be exempted from tuition fees for all years of study, including the M1 and M2 years. PMY students admitted to the MiM programme before September 2026 are also eligible to this specific scholarship policy. This full scholarship covers standard Tuition Fees only.

All other fees such as the Registration fees, pre-requisite courses, additional diplomas, catching up failed courses, diploma deferral, GAP semester/year, etc. must be paid in full.

Students who are not eligible for the CROUS social criteria grants may request a partial exemption from tuition fees based on their financial. Grants will be awarded if possible, based on available budget. Financial need-based scholarships are given for one academic year. They are renewable for following academic years upon submission of a scholarship renewal request on the yearly registration file (April/July).

In all cases, awards are subject to academic results and behaviour in line with the values of the school, or a change in financial situation.



Second section

Financial need-based scholarships for “Classe préparatoire française” admission path.

From September 2026, students that will integrate the Master in Management programme through the “**classe préparatoire française**” admission pathway and who complete the **full 3-year track: Pré-Master Year, M1 and M2**, may be eligible for an ESCP need-based scholarship.

The table below shows the percentages of exemption according to the CROUS* scale:

All other fees such as the Registration fees, pre-requisite courses, additional diplomas, catching up failed courses, diploma deferral, GAP semester/year, etc. must be paid in full.

Students who are not eligible for the CROUS social criteria grants may request a partial exemption from tuition fees based on their financial. Grants will be awarded if possible, based on available budget. Financial need-based scholarships are given for one academic year. They are renewable for following academic years upon submission of a scholarship renewal request on the yearly registration file (April/July).

The following student categories are **not** eligible:

- Direct admissions to M1 students who previously have integrated an Engineering school via the classe préparatoire française admission pathway.
- PMY students who have integrated the ESCP Master in Management programme – 3-year track, before September 2026.

Both profiles can benefit from the policy described in the first section.

In all cases, awards are subject to academic results and behaviour in line with the values of the school, or a change in financial situation.

How to apply

Applications for need-based scholarships open in April and July of the year preceding the signing of the academic contract for entry into ESCP. Eligible students will receive a personal invitation to apply.

The scholarship application must be submitted through the registration file during the scholarship campaign. Applicants are required to include the completed form along with all supporting documents, such as financial statements, proof of citizenship, CROUS certification (if applicable), proof of fiscal residence, and any other mandatory documents.

Scholarship decisions are communicated via personal email following the committee's deliberations. Awarded amounts will be directly deducted from the tuition fees.



Merit-based scholarships

Non-European students admitted through the ESCP Direct Admissions or Join a School in France (SAI) pathways are eligible exclusively for merit-based scholarships. These scholarships are awarded upon admission to the strongest applicants for the Master in Management and range from 25% to 100% of the first-year tuition fees. There is no separate application process for merit-based scholarships.

Merit-based scholarships are granted exclusively for the first year of studies (M1) and are not renewable for the second year (M2).
