# Admission track

## Eligibility conditions

- Have completed your first two years of university education (120 ECTS) towards a non-French degree, outside of France by September 2026.
- Have completed your upper-secondary/college education outside of France.

## Admission sessions

- Fall – Winter – Spring – Summer Admission sessions are organised by Turin campus.

## Admission results

Results will be published on our website on the following dates:

- Fall session: **25 November**
- Winter session: **18 February**
- Spring session: **16 April**
- Summer session: **3 June**

## Evaluation weighting

- **40%** Profile Review
- **30%** Interview
- **20%** Standardised English Test
- **10%** Logic Test – GMAT or SHL

Please note that only shortlisted candidates will be invited to interview.



## Application fees

€180 (on-line payment) **non-refundable**.

## Compulsory documents to upload

- Photocopy of passport or identity card
- Transcript of records obtained during your Bachelor Degree + a certificate of enrolment
- CV
- GMAT, GRE, CAT, TAGE-MAGE or ESCP Test
- Standardised English Test (TOEIC/ IELTS/ TOEFL/ CAMBRIDGE)\*
- Diploma of higher-secondary education
- Cover letter/Personal statement

\* If you are a native speaker (with passport) or if your Bachelor was taught entirely in English in an English speaking country, you may request an exemption.

The exemption grade will be equivalent to 15/20.

If you also have a standardized English test we suggest you to upload it to the on-line application, as we will check if a higher mark is applicable.

## Required English scores

TOEFL IBT 90; IELTS 6.5; Cambridge FCE 175; TOEIC Listening and Reading 900

## Confirmation

If you are admitted to the Pre-Master Year, you must secure your seat by paying a **non-refundable deposit** of **€ 4.000**.
