### **Eligibility conditions**

- Have completed your first two years of university education (120 ECTS) towards a non-French degree, outside of France, by September 2024.
- · Have completed your upper-secondary/ college education outside of France.

- Diploma of higher-secondary education
- Cover letter/Personal statement
- \* If you are a native speaker (with passport) or if your Bachelor was taught entirely in English in an English speaking country, you may request an exemption.

The exemption grade will be equivalent to 15/20.

If you also have a standardized English test we suggest you to upload it to the on-line application, as we will check if a higher mark than 15/20 is applicable.
