Admission requirements

- A Bachelor degree with a **minimum of 180 ECTS**
- A university background preferably in management, economics, social or natural science, or engineering (students from a non-business/economics background will participate in a CatchUp week prior to the start of the programme)
- Fluency in English: TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS scores or English test during admission test
- Work experience not required (if given, a maximum of 2 years is recommended)

2024 fees

For those entering in September 2024, the fees for the two-year programme are as follows:

- Tuition fees: € 15,550 € per year
- Service fee: € 1,000 per year
- Apply by 31 January 2024 to receive an Early Bird tuition fee reduction of 10%
