- A Bachelor degree with a **minimum of 180 ECTS**
- A university background preferably in management, economics, social sciences, or engineering; interest in business development; an entrepreneurial / intrapreneurial profile
- Fluency in English: TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS scores or English test on campus
- Work experience not required (if given, a maximum of 2 years is recommended)

2025 fees

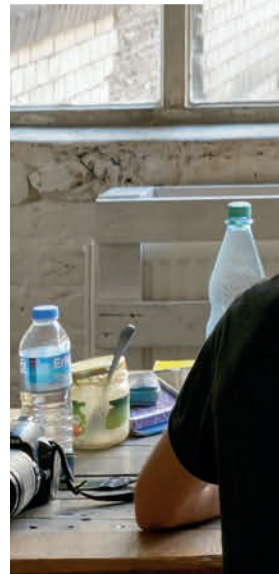
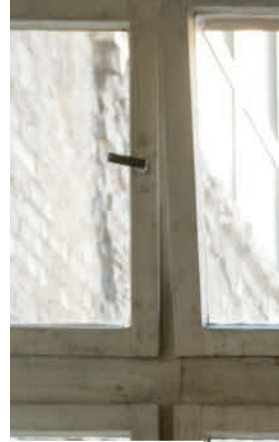
