Requirements

A willingness to work with colleagues from the ESCP campuses in Berlin, London, Madrid, Paris, and Warsaw is highly appreciated. Candidates should also demonstrate skills in developing and expanding relationships with companies and professional organisations and extend the reputation of ESCP Business School and its programmes locally and internationally.

Candidates should have the following characteristics:

- A Ph.D. in a related field, and preferably some post-doc experience. Even if an outstanding doctoral dissertation is required for the application, we will also consider candidates who are in the final stage of their doctoral thesis;
- Evidence of (or clear potential to achieve) excellence in research (publications in leading journals in the field, and/or highly innovative research);
- A passion for research and a genuine interest in working with diverse and stakeholders;
- Experience and interest in teaching diverse student cohorts, mostly in English, applying new teaching methods and formats;
- Fluency in oral and written academic English;
- Strong expertise in international reporting and IFRS is required.
