Do you have an idea for a project with a social impact? Is there an organization working in the social field that you are interested in?

ESCP Business School encourages students to support the local community getting involved with charities caring for various causes (e.g. people in need or with disabilities, education, development). Students may take part in social and humanitarian missions abroad too.

Social projects are usually volunteer service, but Turin Campus and Erasmus+ offer you the chance to receive a scholarship for this period (min 2 months).

This will serve as your B2 professional experience.

If you are not doing a social project, but are interested in the Erasmus+ programme to fund your internship, you can still send your application. This will be taken into consideration only in the event that we do not receive enough requests for social projects. Please see below for details.

WHO

BIM students enrolled in Turin Campus interested in implementing a social project.

WHAT

8 scholarships funded by the Erasmus+ programme, up to 400€ per month (the total amount depends on the requests).

The scholarships will support the participation of students in social projects that should last at least 2 months (max 4 months).

WHERE

The projects should take place in one of the Erasmus+ programme countries (Italy excluded)¹.

Please note that to be eligible, students should reside in a different country than the one where the project takes place.

WHEN

The projects should take place from the end of April to the end of August 2021.

Applications will be open until February 25th 2021 and students will receive the results by mid-March.

HOW

If you want to apply, write down a description of your project (1 page max), including:

1. Summary
2. Objectives
3. Details of the institution/organization where the project takes place

Please attach also a formal letter of approval from the institution/organization.

The projects will be reviewed by a commission made by BIM Academic Director Chiara Succi and representatives of the Student Affairs and Career Service offices. We will take into consideration the originality and impact of the project, its correspondence with ESCP values.
