# Admission track

## Admission sessions

- **2024/2025:** Fall – Winter – Spring – Summer  
The summer session is only open to students with previous studies outside of France. Application deadlines can be found on our website.

- **Sessions** are organised in Berlin, London, Madrid, Paris and Turin

- **Interviews** will take place remotely for all applicants

## Eligibility conditions

Candidates must have a non-French Bachelor Degree issued by a non-French Institution after having completed at least three years of university studies **or** a French degree "Bac+3" with the "visa" of the French Ministry of higher education

## Testing campus (international students only)

You will be assigned to a testing campus based on your current country of residence (all candidates with a French Diploma will be assigned to Paris)

## Evaluation weighting

- **40%** Profile Review
- **30%** Interview
- **20%** Standardised English Test
- **10%** Standardised Management Test

## Shortlist

Please note that only shortlisted candidates will be invited to interview.

## Admission results

Results will be published on our website on the following dates:

- Fall session: **22 November**
- Winter session: **19 February**
- Spring session: **17 April**
- Summer session: **6 June**

- ✕ Scan of passport or identity card
- ✕ Bachelor Degree Diploma or, if you have not obtained it yet, a certificate of enrollment
- ✕ Transcript of records obtained during your Bachelor Degree
- ✕ Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- ✕ Cover letter outlining your motivation to join the programme
- ✕ Standardised English Test (TOEIC/ IELTS/ TOEFL/CAMBRIDGE)\* [valid 2 years]
- ✕ Standardised Management Test (TAGE MAGE/ GMAT/GRE/CAT) [valid 5 years], to be uploaded directly in your application file
- ✕ Letters of recommendation are optional (no required format or convention)

Required English scores:  
TOEFL IBT 90; IELTS 6.5; Cambridge FCE 175; TOEIC Listening and Reading 900

\*English test exemptions:

If you are a native speaker (with passport) or if your Bachelor was taught entirely in English in an English speaking country, you may request an exemption.
